If applicable, please also have official TOEFL, GRE scores sent directly from ETS to Wright State (WSU code is 1179).

As a Wright State student, you **may** need to complete online Mathematics and English writing assessments at least 10 days before your initial advising appointment or Orientation session. The tests **may be required of** admitted students to assess which will be your first math and English class. You have been awarded a tuition scholarship of \$24,000 overall, i.e. \$3,000 per semester for eight semesters, considering just Fall and Spring terms only. You must register for minimum of 12 credit hours every semester and must remain in good standing, i.e., maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.5 each semester, to continue to receive the scholarship in successive semesters.
