MyWSU Login

You should have received an Okta invite to create your **MyWSU** log-in ID and Password credentials. It's imperative you activate your **myWSU** account to receive notifications from the university and to enroll at the university. Immunization Requirements

All WSU students must upload proof of immunizations to your patient portal, according to the **Cougar Health Services policies**. If vaccinations are not in English, a translation must be submitted.

Housing

Washington State University offers many housing facilities/residence halls to choose from based on your needs. **Learn more about our various housing facilities or take an online tour.**

We encourage you to research housing options before visa appointment and to act immediately to secure housing after visa approval. You must **apply for housing** (on or off campus) prior to arrival in the United States.

New Coug Orientation & International Student Tutorial

All students are required to attend the mandatory New Student Orientation, and the International Student Tutorial (both online and in-person components).

All international students will be automatically registered for both of these.

Math & English Placement Exams

Washington State University has two separate placement exams that will need to be completed by new students who do not have transferable college level math or English credit. The **Math Placement Exam** is administered online, and the cost is \$45 which is billed to the student account. The **Writing Placement Exam** can be taken online or in person. The Writing Assessment costs \$58 and is billed to the student. Some students may be exempt from taking this assessment if they have transferable credits from other colleges or from AP/1B/AS/A-Level exams.

University Identification Card (Cougar Card)

The university identification card is your official identification as a university student. The university identification card provides you access to university buildings, residence halls and dining facilities. It will also give you access to free public transportation in the city of Pullman. To receive your university **upload your photo** so that the card is available upon arrival.

Enrolling in Classes

If you are in the Academic English, Undergraduate Foundation, or International Master's programs, you will be enrolled automatically in classes a few weeks before they start. At that point, your classes and tuition bill will be available for you to pay on your myWSU account.

If you are a direct entry bachelor's degree student, you must first attend New Coug Orientation to meet your academic advisor and get enrolled in classes. Once you are enrolled, your tuition bill will be made available on your **myWSU** account.

Paying Your Tuition

All new students are not required to pay tuition fees until the first day of classes! When your bill is available on your myWSU account, you can pay your bill by a **variety of methods**.

Send Us Your Arrival Details

All international students traveling to campus must fill out the International Student Arrival Form, under **Traveling to WSU**. Concierge service is offered from the Pullman Airport to your accommodations.
