Congratulations! On behalf of the Vermont State University community, I am pleased to inform you that you have been admitted to the Biology (B.S.) program at the Castleton campus for the Spring 2025 semester! Acceptance to Vermont State University is always contingent upon successful completion of currently enrolled coursework and any other provision/condition otherwise stated in your admission letter.

In recognition of your academic credentials, you have received a \$5,000 VTSU Better Together and a \$3,500 International Student scholarship for the academic year. Scholarships are awarded each academic year for up to four years if you maintain full-time enrollment and satisfactory academic progress. Scholarships may be used for tuition purposes only.

Scholarships are much more than a recognition of your accomplishments to date. It is an investment in you, in your future, a lift to help you realize your dreams. We believe you have many achievements ahead, at Vermont State University and beyond, and we're excited to support you in fulfilling your goals!

If you have not already done so, please submit your <u>Certificate of Finances and Financial</u> <u>Documentation</u>. This is required and will be reviewed to verify your adaquate financial resources. Once approved, we will mail your SEVIS I-20 required for your visa interview. If you currently have a student visa and would like a transfer request form for your institution please contact Sara Connolly, Admissions Counselor, by emailing <u>sara.connolly@vermontstate.edu</u>.

In order to confirm your matriculation and reserve your place in the class, it will be necessary for you to submit a tuition deposit of US \$200. This deposit will be credited to your tuition bill and is non-refundable. The deposit can be paid on your Application Status page upon completion of your Decision Reply Form.

All students attending Vermont State remain financially responsible with or without scholarship assistance. This includes tuition, fees, room, and board. It also includes incidental living expenses and all international and domestic travel. Health insurance is required for all students enrolled at



Vermont State. This health insurance is mandatory, and you must plan on this expense. A health insurance plan is available to purchase through the university. If you already have sufficient health insurance, you may be eligible for a waiver.

I hope you choose Vermont State and look forward to hearing from you. When you are ready, please complete the <u>Decision Reply Form</u> on your status page to let us know your plans. Accepting your offer of admission will provide next steps for enrollment. You will be required to ensure all checklist items on your Admissions Application Status Page are officially submitted prior to enrollment. Contact admissions if you have questions or need a link to your status page.

As an admitted student, you are now able to connect with your <u>Vermont State University portal</u>!
