Staff are available to help Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m. (CST), Saturday 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. (CST) and Sunday, 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m. (CST).
- **PAWS** is the online system you will use for class registration, financial aid, tuition billing, academic records and maintain personal contact information. Use your ePantherID and password to log into PAWS at paws.uwm.edu.
- **Scholarships:** The International Student Incentive Scholarship is awarded monthly. If receive a scholarship, you will be notified by email.
