Flagship Scholarship Details and Terms:

This scholarship is awarded for the Fall 2025 term. If you decline your admission and choose not to attend UB, this scholarship offer is null and void. These scholarship funds may only be applied toward full-time degree programs; this scholarship cannot be used for non-degree study, summer/winter study, and/or part-time study. You must be enrolled full-time while attending UB and maintain a grade point average (GPA) and cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of at least 3.0 (out of 4.0) while enrolled at UB. You must be pursuing the completion of your degree in a timely fashion (on track to graduate within years). Failure to meet and maintain these minimum requirements will result in loss of the scholarship in subsequent semesters/years. If your New York State residency status changes from Out-of-State to In-State, the amount of your scholarship may be adjusted. If your citizenship status changes to U.S. Permanent Resident, U.S. Citizen, or a legal immigrant status, this scholarship may be adjusted. If you receive a scholarship from another sponsor/source (e.g. government, company, athletic scholarships, or any other scholarship source), your UB scholarship may be adjusted. It is your responsibility to inform the Office of International Admissions about such scholarships you might receive. If your admission is not finalized by the end of your first semester of study, this scholarship may become null and void (no longer available in future semesters).
