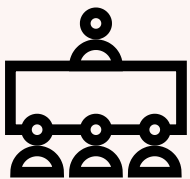

NEXT STEPS

Step 1 Visa

New Incoming International Students: After you have received your I-20, apply for your visa. Start this process early! You can apply up to 365 days before your start date. Your **first step** is paying the SEVIS fee. Print your receipt. Next, complete the visa application form DS-160. **PAY CLOSE ATTENTION** to what you put on your DS-160. It should match your I-20. Mistakes on the DS-160 can lead to visa denials.



Step 3 Virtual Orientation

The virtual orientation must be completed before you arrive on campus. Click the link below to complete the virtual orientation.

Incoming U.S. Transfer Students:

Inform your current U.S. school that you are transferring to Weber State University. Ask them to release your **ACTIVE** status to Weber State University (**DEN214F10097000**) as soon as possible, and no later than the first day of orientation.

HOUSING & RESIDENCE LIFE

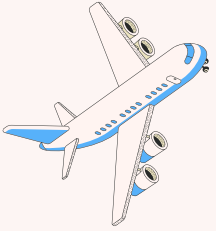

ORIENTATION

The in-person International orientation is **MANDATORY** as stated on your I-20. Please plan accordingly to arrive in time to attend the orientation. Orientation is essential to your success here at Weber State and we will be providing you a host of information to get you started on your journey here at Weber State.

There will be Immigration officials and other University staff here to help you assimilate here at Weber State. More information will be sent via email as it gets closer to the time.
