Dear Ayush,

I am pleased to inform you that you have been accepted to Avila University to pursue a Bachelor's degree on campus in Business Administration at Avila University for the Spring 2025 semester. Congratulations! You are required to complete the arrival form, attend the pre-arrival orientation, and participate in the oncampus orientation from January 4-6. Spring classes will begin on January 6 and end on May 4.

Here are the key dates for Spring 1:

January 4th move in day/Arrival

January 5th International Orientation/ Shopping Trip

January 6th Class begins

January 6th-10th New Student Orientation

F-1 visa students are required to enroll in a minimum number of credit hours, depending on their academic program (typically 12 credit hours/4 courses for undergraduate programs).

If you have completed university-level work in your home country, you are required to complete a course-by-course evaluation of your university transcript (course/grades). The course-by-course evaluation report must be received by our office **before enrollment.** Failure to submit this evaluation will prevent you from enrolling in spring courses.

Health insurance is mandatory for all F-1 students. The total fee for insurance, books, and additional fees for the 2024-2025 academic year is \$2,746. The health insurance fee will be charged to your Avila student account. We highly recommend consulting with our office before purchasing your own insurance policy to ensure it meets the university's requirements; otherwise, you may be charged for both policies.

I am honored to have you in the program and trust that you will be a great success. Avila is so confident in your ability to succeed that we are offering you a scholarship of \$25,815 per year to cover tuition. Scholarship requires students to be enrolled in at least 12 credit hours per academic semester and is applied equally to each term in an academic year.

Next Steps

- (for out of country applicants only) To confirm your attendance at Avila, you must submit a \$200 Admission deposit which will secure your seat in Avila. The deposit is not refundable but will be credited toward your first tuition bill. Please pay your admission Deposit here
- (for transfer applicants from another US universities only) Please send a copy of your current university I-20, I-94, VISA to Avila. Also transfer students MUST have their US University send all official transcripts to Avila. We must have OFFICAL transcripts in order to transfer any possible credits. It is important to remember that we will only accept students who are in active SEVIS Status. If a student is in a terminated status, please hold on to the record and do not transfer to Avila without prior written permission.
- Once your admission deposit is received, your application will be reviewed by the Avila DSO team to confirm that it meets the requirements for an I-20 to be issued. If there are any queries or issues with the documents provided, you will receive a notification from the Avila team.

Please note: I-20s are generally issued within 5 business days after your student record has been created and all required documents have been submitted. If additional documentation of information is needed an admission staff member will contact you directly once the review of documents is completed. When processed, the form I-20 will be forwarded electronically to the email address provided on your admission application.
