Pay Your Deposit

In order to secure your place here at UB, you will need to submit a \$150 tuition deposit. Please note that if you were recently admitted, it can take up to 48 hours for the payment link to become available in your Applicant Status portal. Your tuition deposit must be received by May 1 or within 15 days of the date of this letter, whichever is later. Tuition deposits received after this deadline will be accepted on a space-available basis. The deposit will be applied toward tuition charges for your first semester; it is not refundable after May 1.

Make a Housing Selection

If you intend to live on-campus, we recommend that you submit the <u>Campus Living</u> application and pay your housing deposit as early as possible to ensure your housing selection and preferences are received. May 1 is also the deadline for guaranteed on-campus housing. Campus Living may accept housing applications and deposits after May 1 on a space-available and/or waitlist basis.

Student Visa

If you intend to apply for an F-1 student visa and have submitted the required documents listed in your Immigration Checklist on your Application Status portal, the Office of International Admissions will prepare and email you a digital copy of the I-20 Form (Certificate of Eligibility for Nonimmigrant Student Status) upon receipt of your tuition deposit. If you have not yet submitted the required immigration and/or financial documents, please do so as soon as possible via the Application Status portal.

Provisional Checklist

Most students are admitted to UB based on unofficial and/or scanned copies of academic documents. In order to finalize your admission and be able to register for classes, you are required to submit official, final copies of your academic documents. Please refer to the Provisional Checklist in your Application Status portal. Approximately one month before classes begin, we will email you with information about how to upload those documents. Do not mail the required documents in advance.

Proof of Graduation

If you have not yet completed secondary school, you are required to show proof of graduation prior to your enrollment. You may be subject to dismissal if you arrive on-campus without having graduated from secondary school.

Immunizations and Vaccines

UB and New York State require that all students provide proof of immunity against measles, mumps and rubella, completion of the meningitis information requirement, as well as proof of vaccination for COVID-19.
